

Quality certification of remanufactured cartridges

Dear partner/customer,

The print cartridges we offer are produced in accordance with the quality standards required by the European regulations and certifications recognised in the printing market, as evidenced by the following certificates, among others:





























During the remanufacturing process, we comply with environmental quality standards, during which we try to reuse more than 75% of the toner cartridge components (shell, drum, wiper blade, ...) and 95% of the collected ink cartridges. Some defective parts are repaired or replaced.

The processes are also designed to allow for optimised filling, in some cases exceeding the capacity of the OEM. For jumbo ranges, the amount of powder is increased to at least 125% more capacity. Safety data sheets are available for all products offered, in accordance with the REACH regulation (EC) 1907/2006 REAHC available).

In the case of integration of new parts to replace used parts, a scrutiny is undertaken to confirm the legal use of the part, with respect to the industrial property rights of the original manufacturers (OEM).

Each stage of production is controlled by quality inspectors who ensure that the production stages and standards are respected.
